

## I. Introduction

**BIM Excellence** (BIMe) is a unique *research-based* approach to digital innovation in the construction industry. It provides an integrated methodology and a modular language for performance assessment, learning and process optimisation. The **BIMe Initiative** is *not-for-profit effort* guided by a set of **Principles**<sup>1</sup> undertaken by volunteer researchers from both industry and academia. The BIMe Initiative is supported by in-kind contributions, commercial services, and institutional/corporate [sponsorship](#).

*This document must be read in conjunction with **101in BIMe Initiative Explainer**, **BIMe Initiative Knowledge Structures**, **103in BIMe Initiative Projects** and **104in BIMe Initiative Network** (refer to list of [publications](#)). The BIM Excellence approach and the BIMe Initiative are based on the published research of [Dr. Bilal Succar](#) and a growing cohort of esteemed international collaborators.*

## II. Who is a BIMe Initiative Sponsor

A BIMe Initiative Sponsor is an [organisation](#) committed to supporting the development and open-sharing of structured knowledge across the construction industry. BIMe Initiative Sponsors are either:

- **Educational Institutions** (Tertiary or Vocational);
- **Industry Associations** and **Communities of Practice**; or
- **Corporations** and other commercial enterprises.

The BIMe Initiative promotes the sharing of structured knowledge as widely as possible and thus welcomes the active participation of organisations of all sizes from across the world.

## III. Sponsorship Benefits

A BIMe Initiative Sponsor of any type (refer to Section IV) will receive many General Benefits:

- Sponsor's logo will be prominently displayed on the BIMe Initiative **Sponsors Page** (<http://BIMexcellence.org/sponsors>);
- Sponsor's name and/or logo will be included in relevant public communications; and

## IV. Sponsorship Types and Categories

There are two BIMe Initiative sponsorship *types*, each including a small number of sponsorship *categories*:

### Type A: General Sponsorship

General Sponsorship covers all BIMe Initiative activities, projects and deliverables. There are three **General Sponsorship Categories**, each with specific *eligibility criteria*, *contribution amounts*, *sponsor benefits*, and *participation opportunities* (Table 1):

### Type B: Project Sponsorship

Project Sponsors provide additional contributions to support the development of specific BIMe Initiative Projects. There are two **Project Sponsorship Categories** (Table 2):

<sup>4</sup> Minimum Recommended Support Amount can either be cash payments and/or as approved in-kind contributions. Approved in-kind contributions will vary from one project to another and will be negotiated with potential Project Participants.

## V. Sponsorship Duration

Sponsorship Agreements are yearly with discounts available for multi-year commitments:

- **1 Calendar Year** + (Pro-rata back to July 30th of the same year - discounted at 50%)
- **2 Calendar Years** or more invites a 20% discount on total sponsorship amount
- Sponsorship Agreements are renewed on July 1<sup>st</sup>

Sponsors located in markets where [BIM Adoption](#) is still relatively low<sup>5</sup> will be offered a further 20% discount on monetary contributions.
