

I. Introduction

The **BIMe Initiative** is an international, not-for-profit, community-based effort to improve industry's digital performance. Through high-impact research, free online tools, and open knowledge-sharing under a Creative Commons license, it encourages subject matter experts from across the world to act as a close-knit knowledge community. The BIMe Initiative supports all international efforts that promote open technologies, processes and policies across borders, languages, and disciplines.

The BIMe Initiative is undertaken by committed individuals from both industry and academia. Launched in March 2017, volunteers and sponsors are invited to help us to develop consistent guides and interconnected tools for all to freely use, customise, localise, and continuously improve.

II. BIMe Initiative Sponsors

BIMe Initiative Sponsorship is open to organisations willing to support the community in developing and sharing open-access resources and tools. Sponsors belong to one of three categories

Category A: Educational Institutions (Tertiary or Vocational)

Category B: Industry Associations and **Communities of Practice**

Category C: Corporations and other commercial enterprises

Sponsors are welcome from all industries and sectors but are vetted for alignment with BIMe Initiative's mission. Sponsorship is subject to an agreement clarifying financial contributions and sponsorship benefits.

III. Financial Contributions – Intended Use

Financial contributions by Sponsors will be used to conduct the following activities:

- Developing, testing and maintaining open-access knowledge-sharing websites and online tools;
- Developing and publishing practical resources, templates, and learning materials; and
- Organising free online and offline public events that encourage process innovation.

IV. Sponsorship Benefits

All BIMe Initiative Sponsors across **Sponsorship Tiers** will receive **General Sponsorship Benefits**:

- Sponsor's logo will be prominently displayed on the BIMe Initiative [Sponsors Page](#);
- Sponsor's logo will be included in relevant presentations and public communications; and
- Sponsors can use the BIMe Initiative logo (with a Sponsor Badge) on their website.
